- Receive honor's credits with this class
- Build their resume through real work experience and leadership opportunities

- Acquire skills by working with real life members and understanding how credit unions build relationships with their members
- Attend a two-week mandatory training that will teach financial concepts, marketing, how to make deposits and payments, and the future of technology in the banking industry
- Staff marketing events and gain experience in working with the community and potential members
- Earn money by working at a Christian Financial Credit Union branch
